



Pontraits

PREPARING FOR YOUR SHOOT

Portrait shoots are all about you. A good photographer will ensure that it is your personality and emotion which shines through in that final photograph.

Making you feel comfortable and confident in the studio is my job, and it is what I love. From poses to lighting, I'll help you look your best. I'll be with you the entire time to assist you to turn a good shot into a great one. Together we'll work on achieving the result you came in for.

QUICK TIPS:

- + Pamper yourself with a facial mask/scrub the same for your hair. Have your nails done.
- + Sleep up to 8 hours the night before your shoot, with no interruptions.
- + Wardrobe selection for women, pick our blouse or top that is flattering and the right size, avoid prints and stripes. Very bright colours can make you look a little washed out. Simple earings or necklace, no heavy layer of jewelry. Make sure all slothing is ironed.
- + Wardrobe selection for men, wear similar lothing that would on a date, for casual and to a meeting for work, see above for colours and care. Look at GQ for inspiration. Look at some cool accessories to like; ties, watches, cuff links, pocket watches, pocket squares.
- + For makeup and hair, please read further on in this brochure.





Family Shoots

We all take happy snaps, but a family portrait is something to treasure. Bringing the family together to celebrate the love you have between you is always going to be awesome. The result will be a gorgeous image that you'll be proud to display in your home.

Before your photo shoot, I'll chat with each member of your family, getting to know each one of you as unique individuals. You can also explore the studio before the shoot. This will help you to feel comfortable and confident on the day.

I'll photograph each family member as individuals, capturing the personalities and passions each of you shares. I'll then create a group shot to record those special bonds as images you can treasure.

Imagining your shoot

A family shoot is special, and it is a great opportunity to recall treasured memories and deep bonds. When planning a family shoot, your first step is to decide where you'd like your photograph taken? Would you like a casual shot of you playing together at home or a shot taken in a space which holds treasured memories?

Take your family lifestyle into account. If you have small children, you'll want to create a setting which will keep them happy and occupied. You'll have places you treasure as a family, and these are often great locations for a family photograph. I can capture moments you'll treasure forever. Previously, I've carried out family photographs in parks, in favourite cafés, and in date night locations. A visually appealing space (such as a favourite picnic spot) will add atmosphere to your photos. However, you're also free to come into the studios with some favourite items or props which will make your photo session unique.

Family Portraiture

PREPARING FOR YOUR SHOOT

Book your studio session a couple of weeks in advance so that you can prepare to look your best.

If your children need a haircut, you'll have time. If you're looking for a great outfit, it's time to go shopping. A manicure often makes an excellent touch. Moms often spend time holding their children and hands are very visible in a photo shoot.

Next, it's time to start gathering up props. That special charm your husband gave you after the birth of your first child. The silk scarf you got on your honeymoon. Your child's favourite toy or the rugby top he goes to sleep in at night. This will help you to place your family in the photos, reflecting who you are at this special moment in your lives.

Keep your children in mind when booking a shoot. Your children aren't professionals. Picking the time of day when they are at their best will help you to capture some great moments. Your children may be at their best in the early morning. Or they may be at their best just after nap time. Work with your kids. Tired and impatient children are unlikely to co-operate.



Preparing for your session

- Hair cut or styled the way you want. We do offer this as a service, but it needs to be specified.
- If you are wearing glasses, ensure they are in good repair and clean.
- As little makeup as possible, if you are using our makeup artist as part of your session, if applicable.
- Get a Good night of sleep before.

We will take care of your posing and your facial expressions. For most people having your portrait taken by someone else can be a little daunting, we will they and let you have a good time as this will show the real you in your images.

PREPARING YOUR HAIR

Both women and men should come with their hair styled and ready to be photographed, if you do not decide on using our stylist. For men, try to get your hair cut a few days before your appointment. Make sure nose and ear hair is trimmed. Eyebrows should either be plucked or trimmed the way you like them. Unless you normally wear a beard, have a close shave the morning of the photo session, ensure any nick marks have been cleaned up.

WARDROBE FOR HEADSHOTS

Bring two or more different shirts or tops for your 15-minute session. Clean and ironed is always best. Ensure at least one shirt is a solid colour. Try not to bring all white or black items. Medium tones usually work best, particularly if you opt for black and white photos. Jewel coloured solids always look great.

When choosing your clothing, you need to consider your audience and the message that you would like them to receive. Where will you be using the images, Social media such as LinkedIn, in a brochure or on a website.

If you wear spectacles, then wear them in the photos. Bring multiple pairs if you have them, ensuring that they are clean and in good repair.

MAKEUP

We strongly recommend that if you would like to wear makeup that you make use of our makeup artist. If that is the case, wear as little makeup as possible to speed up the process. Please feel free to bring your own makeup.

Men's clothing

Wearing a Necktie

Learn how to tie a Windsor knot!

Know your audience, if ties are part of your corporate culture, then wear one. If you do opt for a tie, stay away from huge patterns in both your shirt and ties. Solid shirts with a small, patterned tie can look quite sharp. Make you statement with colour rather than patterns. Look at wearing a darker tie with a shirt in lavender, grey or light blue. A blue or red tie works well with a blue or light grey shirts. A white shirt looks good with almost any colour tie. A stripped tie looks best with a solid-coloured shirt. You do not have to wear a tie.

Jacket

The best colours are blue and medium grey. Navy and black can work but the detail in the final image is often lost. A small pinstripe is fine. Match the width of your lapel with the width of your tie. If your lapels are traditional do not wear a slim tie.

If you wear a jacket without a tie, you can be a little more daring with regards to patterns. If you are not using a tie, perhaps opt for a less traditional shirt.

Try not to wear a polo shirt under a jacket as the collars do not lay well. Do not wear ti-shirts under your open collared shirts.

Shirt, no jacket

Try to wear a collared button up shirt, it draws less attention to the neck and frames the face. My recommendation is to always wear a solid-coloured shirt without a jacket. White does not look great and black is not ideal. If you are shooting on a white background then wear a dark shirt, if you are shooting on black of a dark background try to opt for something lighter but not white.

Stripes or patterns tend to be distracting and should be left for images when wearing a jacket.

TIPS

- Make sure your shirt is clean and ironed, do not expect a creased shirt to be 'fixed in Photoshop'
- Make sure your clothes fit before getting to the studio.
- Have a nice belt.
- If your shoes are going to be included make sure they are clean.

Women's clothing

BACKGROUND

Consider your chosen background, black, white, grey or move it to light vs dark background. I normally photograph on black unless a different background is chosen.

If the background is light, then consider medium to dark colours and tones for more contrast. If it is a dark background, then wear light of vivid colours. Red on a black background is a combination I personally really like. We can accommodate most chosen background colours in the studio.

JACKET OR BLAZER

If you are going for a formal look opt for a blazer or suit. With a headshot it will not be obvious if you are wearing pants or a skirt since the upper body is they key focus. We prefer medium to dark tones for a jacket such as navy, blue or dark grey, but red photographs well. Stay away from white if you can, the eye is always drawn to the brightest spot of the image.

Add a pop of colour with a collarless blouse or camisole or with a jewel of crew neck. Try some options other than white on the blouse. Pick a colour that compliments the jacket. Stay away from big patterns that become distracting. Collared shirts can work, think of putting the collar outside of the jacket collar.

SHIRT OR BLOUSE ONLY

Consider jewel tone as on the previous pages. Solid colours work better than patterns. If you do want a printed pattern, please try a small pattern or low contrast, you want the viewers focus on your face not your wardrobe. Purple, emerald, sapphire blue, purple, green, red, or orange can work well.

As far as neck styles for you can create a more formal look with a collar, but collarless can also work well,

DRESSES

Dresses work well in headshots; they over possess great colour or fabric texture that translate well. Heavier fabrics can look nice. Try to avoid a blazer over a dress. A lower neckline may end up cropped out of the photo. Try to avoid any neckline that falls at or above the collar bone. If you are having your shoot for a business find out if they want the arms and shoulders not to show as many companies prefer not to show them, we may include them in unless specified by you.

SCARVES

Scarves can add a pop of colour, if wearing a scarf keep in mind that only the upper part of the body will be included in your headshot.

Family Portraiture

Bring some snacks and drinks for your children to enjoy. Full children are happy children and this makes for a great photo experience. You could also use treats as bribes.

Dress according to the weather! You want to be warm enough without feeling overheated.


Layering is often a great option for transient weather temperatures. If you're too hot or too cold, you won't enjoy your photo session.


Try to match your outfits in style or tone, but don't worry about looking too similar. It will look better if each one of you shows your uniqueness. You can choose more than one outfit if you'd like to.

Bring a change of clothes for your children in case of accidents, mud or mess.

Accessories such as hats or scarves will add interest or creativity to your shoot. A dash of colour is an absolute must.

If you're not sure what to do, search for ideas on Pinterest. Confidence is key in photographs though, so do make sure you feel like yourself.









Family Portraiture

PREPARING FOR YOUR SHOOT

Most of all, relax. The very best family photographs are made up of moments you naturally share together. An expression between a mother and a child, the chemistry between a couple or the interactions between siblings will stand out. Posed images will never compare.

Nurture yourself.

Before the shoot, prepare to look your best. Go for a manicure or a pedicure. Get yourself a great haircut. Our make-up artists will be able to assist you on the day, should you require this. This is a great option because they have experience with what looks best on camera.

Lastly, don't forget your props! This can be baby's sonogram photos, special gifts you treasure or your child's favourite toy. Whatever you choose should bring should be meaningful to your family!

Remember, this is all about YOU!!



Maternity

PREPARING FOR YOUR SHOOT

A maternity shoot is about celebrating your own body along with your upcoming motherhood. It's a time of romance between you and your partner as you prepare to shape new relationships while celebrating old ones.

Before the shoot, focus on getting a manicure and pedicure done, getting your hair styled and feeling pampered. This may be your last opportunity for a while! Our makeup artists will help you with your studio make, up if required. Alternatively, if you would like to do your own make up, put on a little extra for the camera.

Props

Select any props you would like to bring to the photo shoot. This could include images of your baby, special gifts your partner has given you, symbols of your relationship together, or gifts for your baby.










Maternity


Photo editing can be fairly simplistic or quite complex. You may have heard of photo editing referred to as Photoshopping, retouching or even airbrushing. Our goal is to give you magazine quality images by making slight adjustments. Professional makeup and lighting is already going to make a big difference to your images.

This process, depending on our workload, usually takes around 14 to 21 working days, if you need your images quicker, at a premium we can accommodate you.

We offer two types of editing, Standard Editing and Advanced Editing, one taking considerably more time than the other.

EDITS

- + Reduce wrinkles, this is not always required.
- + Remove spots, pimples and bruises as well as other blemishes.
- + Removal of Stretchmarks and Cellulite.
- + Your eyes will also be slightly enhanced.
- + Advanced skin softening will be applied.
- + Nipping and tucking and can even make you look slightly slimmer.
- + Dodging and Burning, which is where we make the image stand out more, almost giving it a 3 dimensional look.


